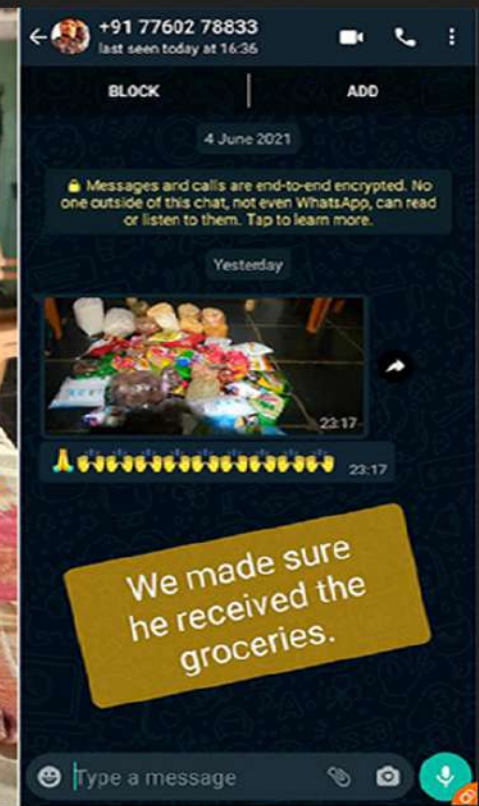
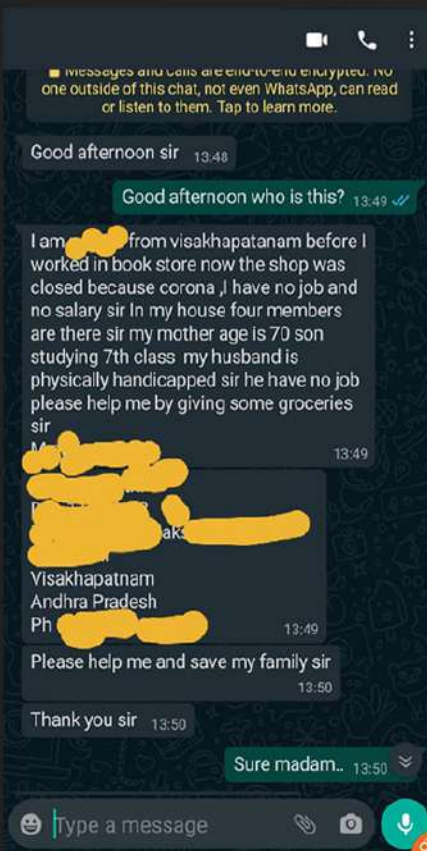
Since April 2021, we have been working in partnership with Asha Kiran Trust from Hubli, Karnataka Dream a world Foundation, Jabalpur , Madhya Pradesh and also Corner Stone Foundation from Hyderabad, Telangana. In the coming years we would also like to collaborated with Bethesda Seva and Able Society from Andhra Pradesh as these both foundations also share the same vision of reaching the unreached communities with basic provisions.

Our main focus is on 4 states: Karnataka, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh . 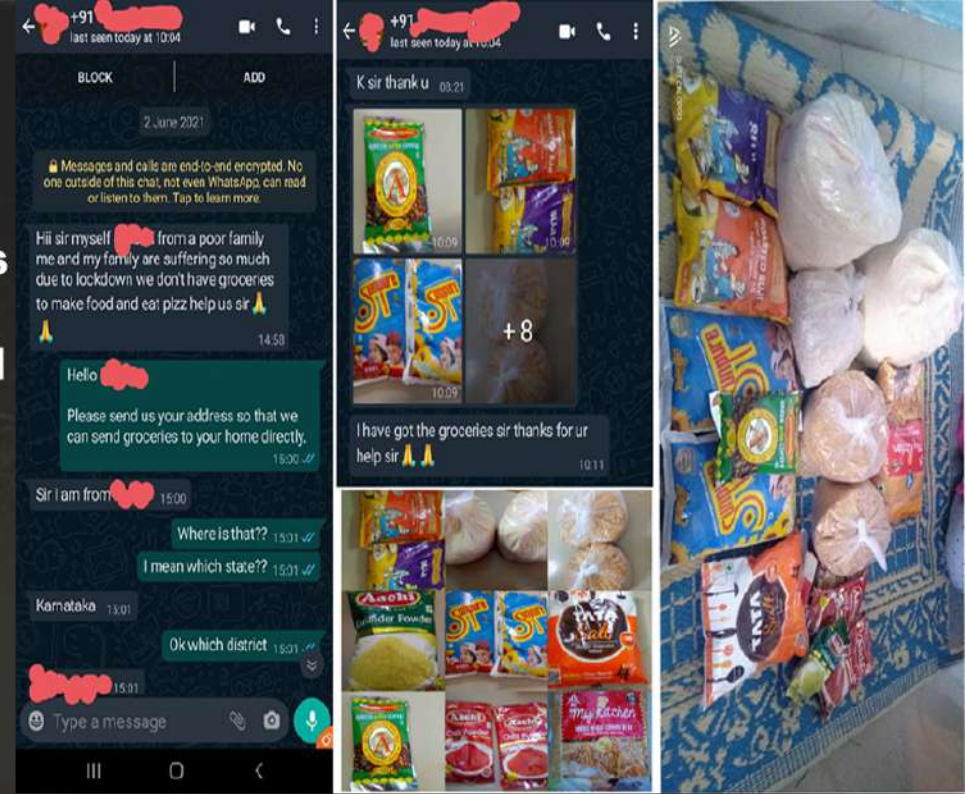
